Scholarship Application Instructions

for the 2007 - 08 Academic Year

Eligibility:

- Applicant/Recipient must be an initiated member in good standing of Phi Mu Fraternity. (Reference Phi Mu Fraternity Bylaws, Article 8, Section 2.)
- Applicant/Recipient must have a cumulative **GPA of 3.0** or above (on a 4.0 scale).
- Recipients must remain in an accredited college or university working toward a degree, credential or certificate during the 2007- 08 academic year. All undergraduate recipients must be enrolled as full-time students as defined by their college or university.
- More than one scholarship may be awarded to members of the same collegiate chapter. However, a member may receive no more than one scholarship per year and not more than three scholarships during her collegiate and alumnae academic career.

Instructions:

Please type or print very clearly. Complete only one application form. The Scholarship Committee will determine eligibility for specific scholarships. Applicants will be rated equally on GPA, Phi Mu and community involvement, personal statements, financial need and recommendations. Each category can receive a maximum of five points. Donors to Phi Mu Foundation will receive extra consideration. Since the Scholarship Committee can consider only the information contained in the application packet, please be as thorough as possible when providing the requested material. The Scholarship Committee will make every effort to award every available scholarship. However, there will be more applicants than available financial assistance.

Submit the following in **one** envelope:

- Completed Scholarship Application.
- Official transcript from **each** college or university attended. Do NOT send an unofficial transcript printed from your computer.
- Two Recommendations must be submitted on the Phi Mu Foundation Recommendation Form.
 - Undergraduate applicants: Submit one from the chapter adviser and one from an academic source or employer.
 - Graduate applicants or alumnae returning as undergraduates: Submit two recommendations from academic or professional sources.

Only applications submitted with all requested materials will be considered by the Scholarship Committee. Applications must be postmarked on or before **March 1, 2007**. Late applications will not be considered.
